### The Brief

The King Edward VII Memorial Hospital (KEMH) in Stanley, is the Falkland Islands' only hospital. The Falkland Islands Government (FIG) has identified a plan for significant improvements at the hospital which includes the extension and modernisation of the current facilities.

## **Project Overview**

One Creative Environments Ltd. has been commissioned for Phase One of the extension and modernisation plans for the King Edward VII Memorial Hospital (KEMH).

The current operating theatre suite is as originally constructed and is not capable of performing specialist operations, such as orthopaedics. Islanders requiring any specialist treatment need to be flown back to the U.K. or overseas in emergencies, requiring careful logistical management and at great cost to the Government.

This vital project will provide two new state-of-the art operating theatres, that will enable more complex procedures to take place on the island, as well as X-Ray and CT scanning facilities. The development will also make more efficient use of space for new offices, workshop and stores.

The project is currently moving through the concept design stage, developing towards selection of specialist suppliers and submission of a Planning Application. Once fully designed and tendered, the works will be due for commencement on site in October 2018.

One is the Principal Designer and is providing all of the necessary building design services: Architecture, Structural and Civil engineering, Building Services and Landscape Architecture working in a Building Information Modelling (BIM) environment – the future of intelligent design.

This is the third contract that One has been awarded on the islands in recent months. The company has also been commissioned by the Tourist Board to design a shelter, toilet/baby changing and washing facilities nestled in the very remote and beautiful, Gypsy Cove.
